Internationally acclaimed expressionist painter, printmaker, sculptor, author and teacher, Bert Seabourn is the recipient of several notable honors. In 1976 he was designated as Master Artist by the Five Civilized Tribes in Muskogee, Oklahoma. In 1981, he received the Oklahoma Governor's Art Award. Oklahoma City University awarded him an Honorary Doctorate of Human Letters. His works are in private and public collections worldwide including:

The Vatican Museum of Religious Art in Rome; The National Palace Museum in Taiwan; the Smithsonian Museum of National History, Washington, D.C.; The National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum in Oklahoma City, The President Gerald Ford Library; The Oklahoma City Museum of Art, and the private collection of George and Barbara Bush. An active octogenarian, Bert continues to experiment with color, style and technique. The innovations in his work continually surprises and delights the viewer.
