John Wolfe was born in Vernon, Texas, August 23, 1947. He attended public school in Davidson, Oklahoma, and graduated from Southwestern Oklahoma State University in 1970 with a degree in Art Education. Wolfe completed his M.Ed. at the University of Central Oklahoma in 1976. He has taught art in the Midwest City-Del City School System for 30 years and has served as adjunct art faculty at Rose State College and at Adams State College in

Alamosa, Colorado. Wolfe conducts an annual watercolor workshop in Taos, New Mexico presented by Adams State College. Since his retirement, Wolfe spends his time at his studio in Oklahoma City where he continues to work on his sculpture and painting. His large metal sculptures are installed in front of the Gallery for public viewing.
